

JAIL RULES

MINOR VIOLATIONS SHALL INCLUDE ACTS WHICH DO NOT CONSTITUTE A PRESENT AND IMMEDIATE THREAT TO THE SECURITY OF THE FACILITY, ITS STAFF, INMATES, VISITORS, OR THE INMATE WHO COMMITTED THE VIOLATION. SUCH VIOLATIONS SHALL INCLUDE BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO :

A - MINOR : Failure to comply with jailer's/deputy's lawful order; From 0700 hrs - 2300 hrs you must keep your bed made and stay fully clothed. If you want to lay down you are allowed to lay on top of your blankets.

.B - MINOR : Profanity, derogatory remarks, or gestures to any member of the staff, visitors, or fellow inmates.

C - MINOR : Unnecessary noise such as arguing, shouting, whistling, rattling, or pounding on doors or windows.

D - MINOR : Loud talking or unnecessary noise after lights out.

E - MINOR : Failure to perform routine duties such as cleaning the cell and making beds during prescribed hours.

F - MINOR : "Horse Playing", teasing, or verbally harassing another inmate.

MAJOR VIOLATIONS SHALL INCLUDE PERSISTENT MINOR RULE INFRACTIONS AND RULE VIOLATIONS WHICH CANNOT BE CONSIDERED MINOR BUT DO NOT CONSTITUTE A PRESENT AND IMMEDIATE THREAT TO THE SECURITY OF THE FACILITY. VIOLATIONS INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO :

A- MAJOR : Repeated minor violations

B - MAJOR : DISOBEYING A JAILER/DEPUTY

C - MAJOR : LYING TO JAILER/DEPUTY

D - MAJOR : FIGHTING, MOLESTING

E - MAJOR : MINOR DAMAGE OF FACILITY PROPERTY (LESS THAN \$50)

F-MAJOR : ABUSING COMMISSARY VISITING TELEPHONE AND OR LEISURE PRIVILEGES

G-MAJOR : ABUSING FOOD SERVICES

H-MAJOR : ATTEMPTING TO CONTROL THE BEHAVIOR OF OTHER INMATES THROUGH COERCION, FORCE ,THREAT ASSIGNING WORK TO OTHER INMATES

I-MAJOR : DISRUPTING RELIGIOUS, MEDICAL OR FOOD SERVICES OR ANY OTHER ACTIVITY OR PROGRAM

J-MAJOR : SMOKING

K-MAJOR : RETENTION OF ANY MEDICATION ISSUED AT THIS FACILITY OR FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE

L-MAJOR : WRITING ON THE WALLS OR FURNITURE

SERIOUS VIOLATIONS SHALL INCLUDE ACTS, WHICH CONSTITUTE VIOLATIONS OF STATUTORY LAW AND/OR PRESENT AN IMMEDIATE THREAT TO THE SECURITY OF THE FACILITY. SUCH ACTS SHALL INCLUDE BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO: :

A-SERIOUS : REPEATED MAJOR VIOLATIONS

B-SERIOUS : ASSAULT ON ANOTHER INMATE OR STAFF MEMBER

C-SERIOUS : ESCAPE, ATTEMPTED ESCAPE

D-SERIOUS : POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR UNAUTHORIZED DRUGS

E-SERIOUS : THEFT

F-SERIOUS : DAMAGE OF FACILITY PROPERTY(IN EXCESS OF \$50.00)

G-SERIOUS : INTERFERING WITH SECURE OPERATION OF THE FACILITY

H-SERIOUS : ARSON

I-SERIOUS : POSSESSION OF A WEAPON OR CHEMICAL AGENT OR ANY OBJECT WHICH HAS BEEN MODIFIED SO IT MAY BE USED AS A WEAPON
J-SERIOUS : CREATING OR INCITING A RIOT
K-SERIOUS : MALICIOUS DESTRUCTION, ALTERATION OR MISUSE OF PROPERTY
L-SERIOUS : STOPPAGE OR PLACEMENT OF FOREIGN MATTERS INTO THE TOILET OR SINK

PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS : THE ONLY ALLOWABLE PENALTIES INCLUDE THE DENIAL OF PRIVILEGES, PLACEMENT IN ISOLATION OR A COMBINATION OF BOTH. PENALTIES SHALL BE PROPORTIONATED TO THE OFFENSE AND SHALL BE ASSESSED FOR A SPECIFIC LENGTH OF TIME. PENALTIES MAY BE LESS THAN, BUT SHALL NOT EXCEED THE FOLLOWING MAXIMUM TIME LIMITS: TO ALSO INCLUDE THOSE ALLOWED BY LAW BUT NOT ENUMERATED HERE.

1: : MINOR VIOLATIONS : 48 HOURS (2 DAYS) MAXIMUM
2: : MAJOR VIOLATIONS: 120 HOURS (5 DAYS) MAXIMUM
3: : SERIOUS VIOLATIONS: 240 HOURS(10 DAYS) MAXIMUM .
